Main St., Oneida, NY on a proposed Local Law to amend the City's Zoning Regulations, Chapter 190, so as to reduce the number of members on the ZBA from seven to five within the City of Oneida.

**A LOCAL LAW TO AMEND CHAPTER 190, TITLED "ZONING," OF  
THE CODE OF THE CITY OF ONEIDA TO REDUCE THE NUMBER  
OF MEMBERS ON THE ZONING BOARD OF APPEALS**

Be it enacted by the Common Council of the City of Oneida as follows:

**SECTION 1. AUTHORITY.**

This local law is enacted pursuant to the New York State Constitution and New York Municipal Home Rule Law §10.

**SECTION 2.**

So that the introductory paragraph of Section190-44 of the City of Oneida Zoning Regulations, titled "Zoning Board of Appeals," is hereby amended so as to read, in its entirety, as follows:

"A Zoning Board of Appeals consisting of five (5) members shall be designated by the Common Council to carry out the duties prescribed for such Board under these regulations[.]"

**SECTION 3.**

So that Section190-44(A)(2) of the City of Oneida Zoning Regulations is hereby amended so as to read, in its entirety, as follows:

“(2) Membership and terms. The Zoning Board of Appeals shall consist of five members, including the Chairman, the successors to the original appointees shall be appointed for terms of three years from and after the expiration of the terms of the members first appointed. No person who is a member of the Common Council shall be eligible for membership on such Zoning Board of Appeals.”

**SECTION 4.**

So that Section 190-44(B)(1)(c) of the City of Oneida Zoning Regulations is hereby amended so as to read, in its entirety, as follows:

“(c) Voting requirements. The concurring vote of three members of the Zoning Board of Appeals shall be required to constitute an official action by the Board.”

**SECTION 5.**

This Local Law shall be effective upon filing with the office of the Secretary of State.
