The meeting was called to order at 2:04 pm by Chairman Bruce Burke.

Copies of the minutes from the July meeting were distributed prior to the meeting date. A motion was made by Barb Bruehner and seconded by Shirley Lomery Barb Bruehner to accept the minutes as written. Motion carried.

1. The first agenda item was for the loading zone for Dr. Costello's office. There were still many questions and no additional response so a motion

to table discussion was made by Barb Bruehner and seconded by Shirley Lomery. Motion carried.

2. Parking on one side of the street on West Street between Washington and Stone Street. After discussing the situation in the area and looking at the survey by the Councilman in that ward, Jim Chamberlain, a motion was made by Barb Bruehner and seconded by Jim Sweet that there be "No Parking on this side of the Street" on the EAST side of West Street between Washington Av and Stone Street. Motion carried.
3. Request for "Children at Play" sign at 2313 Fairview Ave. A copy from the Cornell Local Roads Program regarding Children at Play signs was distributed to the members of the Traffic Safety Board. After reading this reference which was suggested by Jon Rauscher the traffic safety board decided to take no action on this request and a letter would be drafted by the Chairman to send to Ms. Meacham.
4. A request was made to change some of the Handicapped signs in front of City Hall to 15 minute parking. A motion was made by Jim Dalzell to change 2 of the Handicapped parking spaces to 15 minute parking spaces. The motion was seconded by Barb Bruehner. Motion carried.
5. There was a request made by the Mayor regarding parking behind the Colonial Laundromat. This request was withdrawn by the Mayor due to the area eventually being public parking for the rail-trail and that particular signage was not needed.
6. There was discussion on an issue with signage at Williams Street and Madison Street. B. Anderson was to check the sign inventory for the area. If no order then one will need to be done for no parking from here to corner on the WEST side of Williams Street from the corner to 15 feet from the intersection. If an order is needed a motion was made by Jim Sweet and seconded by Shirley Lomery. Motion carried.
